

Protection Concept for the Staff and Visitors
Migros Museum für Gegenwartskunst
December 20, 2021

Purpose

In accordance with the rough concept for museums by the Swiss Museums Association VMS and based on the guidelines issued by the Swiss Federal Office of Public Health (FOPH) and the State Secretariat for Economic Affairs (SECO) regarding occupational health and safety in the workplace, this Directive governs the implementation of hygiene and social distancing measures in the Migros Museum für Gegenwartskunst (also for events organized by the museum). This Directive is an individual protection concept that takes into consideration specific characteristics (building, staff, etc.).

Scope

This directive shall apply for the reception, shop and exhibition area of the Migros Museum für Gegenwartskunst, Limmatstrasse 270, 8005 Zurich., as well as for events.

1. COVID certificate obligation

- For persons 16 years and older, access to the museum is only possible upon presentation of a COVID certificate 2G (vaccinated or recovered) authorized in Switzerland.
- To visit the museum, the COVID certificate must be presented in combination with an official identification document with photo (for example, passport, identity card, driver's license, residence permit, student ID or SwissPass) upon arrival at the museum.
- The certificate requirement also applies to on-site events and art education programs.

2. Maintaining a Safe Distance from Others & Masks

- A distance of 1.5 meters must be maintained between all visitors and employees at all times.
- All visitors over 12 years of age are required to wear a mask throughout the entire Löwenbräukunst site (indoor). Please bring your own mask.
- Supervisory staff are authorized to regulate the numbers of visitors entering the museum.
- A pane of plexiglass is installed at the reception (information point and cash register) as a protective device for staff and visitors.

3. Hand Hygiene at the Cash Register/Reception/in the Shop


- The Migros Museum für Gegenwartskunst will provide visitors and staff with disinfectant. The disinfectant will be regularly refilled.
- Employees shall wash their hands regularly with soap and water at the workplace, as well as before and after breaks.
- The exhibition does not include any objects, furnishings or audio guides that can be touched.
- The exhibition booklet can be downloaded onto a smartphone via QR code or printed out at home.

3. Cleaning

- Frequently touched surfaces, such as elevator buttons, door handles and banisters in the museum and on the Löwenbräukunst site will be disinfected regularly by cleaning staff.

4. Information

- Staff and visitors will be regularly informed about all of the measures taken.
- Supervisory staff are authorized to intervene in the event of risky behavior.
- We kindly ask that you do not visit the Migros Museum für Gegenwartskunst should you experience any symptoms of illness.
